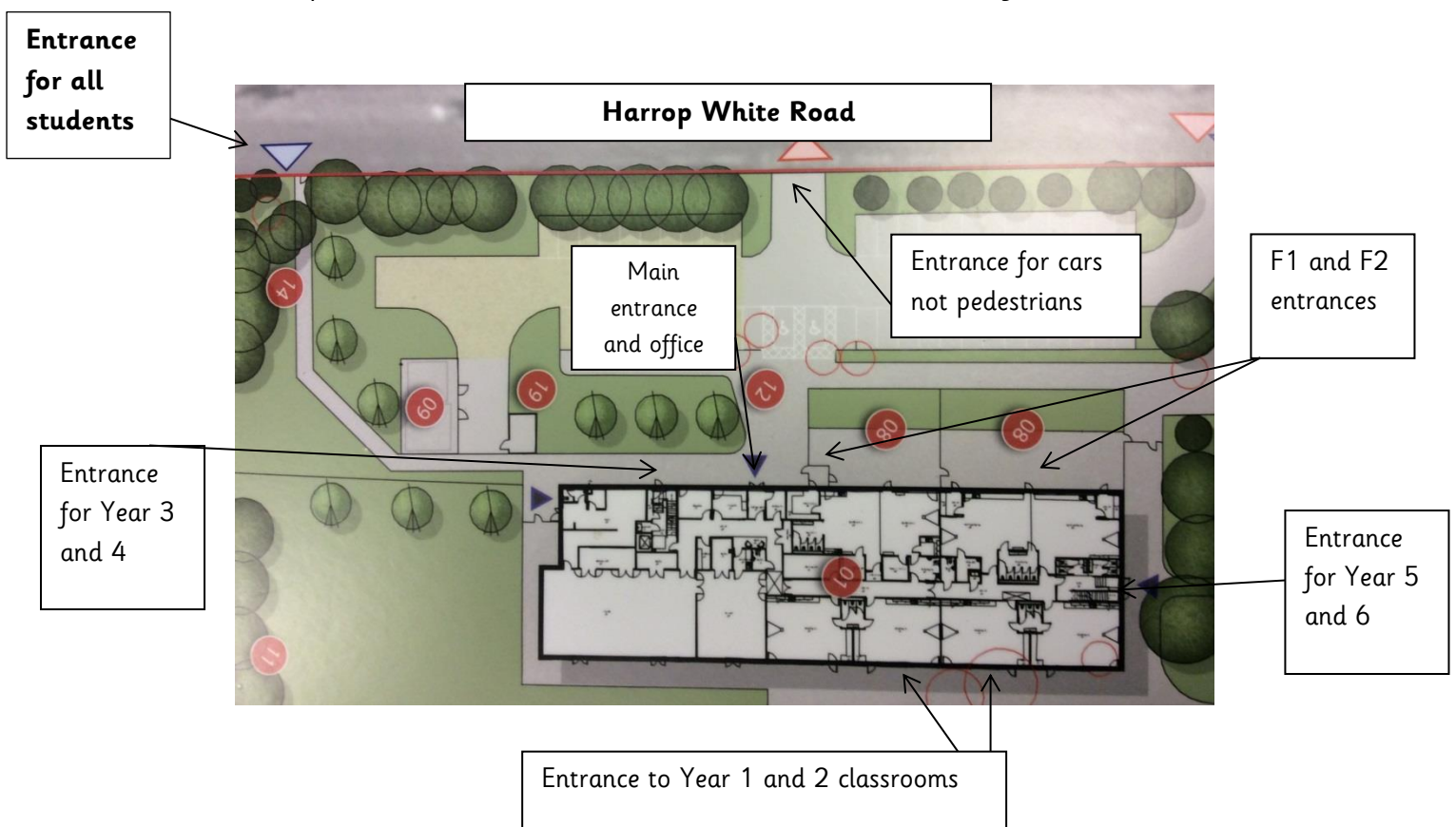

Access to our new school building

School reopens on Thursday 25th February. We look forward to seeing you all on that first day. Don't worry about knowing where to go as there will be lots of staff on hand to direct you.

Here's some information to help you navigate your way around our new site. Please see the information below as if you are stood facing the building:

- There will be one pedestrian entrance from Harrop White Road.
- Nursery and Reception (F2P and F2W) are at the front of the school.
- Classes 2P, 2W, 1P and 1W will all be at the back of the school. These classes have their own separate door leading straight into the classrooms. These classrooms can be accessed by walking around the back of the school.
- Classes 3P, 3W, 4P, 4W are all upstairs – The entrance to these classes are through a door at the front of the building. The door is to the right of the main entrance.
- Classes 6P, 6W, 5P and 5W are all upstairs. The entrance to these classes is on the left hand side of the building
- All cloakrooms are inside the classrooms.
- Doors will open as usual at 8:50am and children can make their way to their new classroom.



School Uniform
