Based at Ladybrook Community Centre and run by Ladybrook Enterprises Ltd, Mansfield Community Foodshare project has been set up to reduce the amount of fresh, edible food and produce which is sent to landfill every year in the UK by large supermarkets.

In partnership with FareShare and Tesco we are able to offer food items here at the centre to people who would like to utilise them. All food is still edible and is ideal for freezing.

Available for collection from the community centre during our drop in hours of 12-3 every weekday afternoon, all food is available to take with a maximum of 5 items per person - pay what you can afford on the day (if you cannot afford anything this time that's fine!)

The aim of the project is to stop the food from being wasted whilst offering an opportunity for the people of Mansfield and District to access low cost or free food if they need to or want to help to save the environment.
