



Sport Premium Grant 2017-18

What is the Sport Premium Grant?

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for Physical Education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision. This funding is ring fenced to be used for sport specific areas to make an impact in Physical Education and Sport in schools.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and Sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

Funding received: We are awaiting our Sport Premium Allocation. We are anticipating at grant of £19 500 to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils, in the 2017 to 2018 academic year to give them the opportunity to develop a healthy lifestyle. The funding allocation to sport premium has been increased this year in line with government policy.

How will we use the Sport Premium Grant at Wainwright Primary Academy 2017/18?

Area		Intended Impact
Outdoor Play Equipment & storage	£1500.00	Play equipment is purchased so that children at all ages are active in their play and storage allows self access to this.
Sports competitions, trophies,	£600.00	Pupils participate in interschool competitions and are given the chance to demonstrate their skill and gain confidence in addition to the physical

Sports Coach	£10,000.00	Pupils participate in high quality PE lessons . Pupils have the opportunity to participate in team games over lunchtime.
Field & Playground Markings	£3,400.00	Pupils will be able to play team games and participate in sports with appropriate facilities during PE lessons , after school and in competitive games. Pupils are engaged in physical activity during unstructured times of the day
Additional school swimming	£4,000.00	Pupils who have accessed school swimming and have been unable to swim a distance of 25m will be given an additional opportunity. Pupils will have been given the best opportunity to achieve the ability to swim 25m by the end of Y6

What impact did the Sport Premium Grant have for our children in 16/17?

The impact of the funding in 2016/17 included:

- Playground Equipment – Pupils engaged in purposeful activity at playtime
- Membership of local schools partnership and participation in inter school events – increased participation in interschool events
- Sports equipment – Allowed wider range of sports to be taught
- Football kits – Football team had Wainwright identity and wore with pride
- Specialist coach to deliver quality PE – Quality sessions delivered each afternoon across school
- Staff to lead after school and lunchtime clubs – Pupils are active and engage in sport participation within the extended day.
